PROJECT MANAGEMENT & QAQC OF LRV REBUILD FOR MTR

Client: UGL

Location: Dalian/Hong Kong

Key Services: Audits, Inspections & Testing

Scope: Inspection of the manufacturing of two new body shells for MTR Light Rail Vehicles (LRVs) that were damaged during operation in Hong Kong.

Approach and Achievements:

MADEPARTNERS assigned qualified professionals to carry out welding inspections to confirm compliance with Australian standards and MTR/UGL specifications. We were subsequently invited by UGL to become the project manager for the re-assembly of the LRVs onto the new body shells and commissioning to put them back into service.

Scope: Provision of QAQC services for the design and manufacture of 14 Progress Rail locomotives in the USA and the prototype testing and series manufacture of 536 CRRC wagons in China.

Approach and Achievements:

Use of MADEPARTNERS' Australian-based Independent Competent Person (ICP) to remotely carry out the verification of the locomotives and wagons in conjunction with our onsite QAQC teams, streamlined the certification process with significant cost savings to the client.

For the locomotives, our role included the preparation of a business case to justify their purchase, verifying the suitability of the identified second-hand locomotives, and development of maintenance plans. For the wagons, it included the development of a specification, obtaining requests for quotation, recommendation of the preferred tenderer and quality management.

QAQC OF GRAIN SILOS FOR CBH

Client: CBH

Location: Venice, Italy

Key Services: QAQC

Scope: CBH procured two (2) grain silos from Italian equipment supplier AGI-Frame

Approach and Achievements:

MadePartners carried out a Quality Assurance focused audit of the suppliers quality management system and capability, along with a follow on Quality Control focused inspection and verification of product conformance. Focus was placed on components of the silos that were of new design, and manufactured by a newly commissioned robotic welding process, both of which presented and increased quality risk profile. MadePartners on-site presence helped identify key assembly risks, encouraging the supplier to carry out critical trial fitment, de-risking the assembly process in Australia which would have resulted in substantial and additional cost if rework was required.

Scope: Quality Management for manufacture of three flotation cells for Glencore.

Approach and Achievements:

Our onsite team identified non-conformances and performance against schedule and worked with the factory to close out the quality issues and project recovery initiatives. Project was carried out to meet cost, delivery and quality requirements.

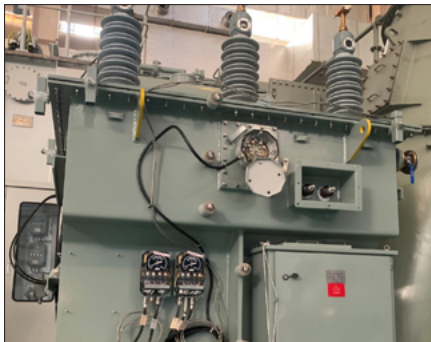

Scope: Provision of QAQC services during the manufacturing of three longwalls.

Approach and Achievements:

Three longwalls were to be manufactured by CBMJ in China for the Mooranbah, Grosvenor and Aquila mines. MADEPARTNERS provided QAQC services to verify compliance with the ITPs, identify non-conformances and verify remediation of the appointed non-conformances. Our services were particularly valuable as this project was carried out during Covid.

INSPECT & WITNESS FINAL ASSEMBLY OF 2 X 14MVA TRANSFORMERS

Location: Wuhan, China

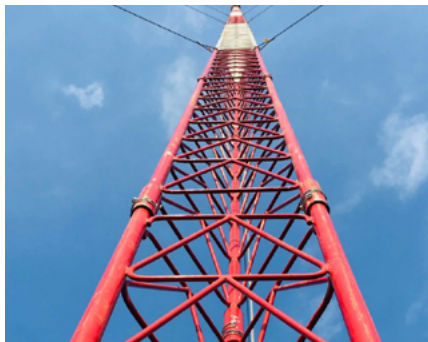

Scope: Aurizon procured two (2) x 14MVA auto transformers for their electrified network from GE Grid Australia Pty Ltd. GE manufactured the transformers at their workshop in Wuhan, China. MADEPARTNERS was engaged to witness the Factory Acceptance Testing.

Approach and Achievements:

MADEPARTNERS reviewed both Aurizon and GE specifications and measured specification gap and manufacturing and testing compliance.

Thirty (30) non-conformances were identified during the inspection and witness of the testing and closed out before shipping to Australia



SUPPLIER ASSESSMENT AND PROTOTYPE INSPECTION OF A MET TOWER FOR ART

Location: Qingdao, China

Key Services: Technical Translation, Benchmarking, Supplier Assessment & Prototype Inspection

Scope: Factory due diligence, audit of the suppliers' capabilities and carry out inspection of the prototype tower module.

Approach and Achievements:

ART designs, manufactures, installs, and maintains turnkey infrastructure solutions for renewables, resources and communications industries, ultimately they measure wind resources and provides the high quality bankable data.

MADEPARTNERS approach to validate the offshore manufacture of ART towers was by providing technical translation and factory due diligence services to support the audit of the suppliers' capabilities and carry out inspection of the prototype antenna module. Twenty opportunities for improvement were identified and adopted.



WITNESS & VERIFY FAT OF ACEREZ HV CIRCUIT BREAKERS

Location: Beijing, China

Key Services: Witness FAT & Quality Assurance

Scope: Witness Factory Acceptance Testing (FAT) for three sets of high-voltage circuit breakers (550 kV, 420 kV and 72.5 kV) manufactured by Hitachi Energy for the Central West Orana Renewable Energy Zone project, verifying compliance with IEC 62271-100 and ANSI/IEEE C37.09 standards.

Approach and Achievements: High-voltage circuit breakers are mission-critical assets where incomplete testing can have serious consequences. Acting as the client's eyes on the ground, our inspector attended all four days of FAT activities at Hitachi Energy's Beijing facility, identifying deviations and omissions as they arose. Findings were formally recorded across four daily Flash Reports and a Final Report, giving ACEREZ a reliable audit trail for future reference.

Process Automation & Controls (PAC) were ISO9001 certified but needed help to get the full benefit of their QMS. MADEPARTNERS carried out a gap analysis and established a plan to migrate their QMS from a generic system to one that drives continuous improvement. This is an ongoing project that continues to deliver value and improved outcomes to PAC.

This outcome was an increase in sales and faster product approval rates.
